Please pray for him as he moves on as a professor at our Dominican School of Philosophy & Theology, and then later when he goes on for his doctorate in Rome.

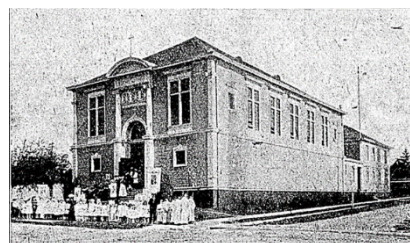

It would only take a few people to ignore or defy the Archbishop's guidelines, and we could find our new-found freedoms snatched away. This is something that we don't want because it could affect our future access to the Sacraments. Regardless, I'm proud of the way that our parish has handled the situation. It hasn't been easy, but as Jesus has shown us by his example: sacrifice is necessary.

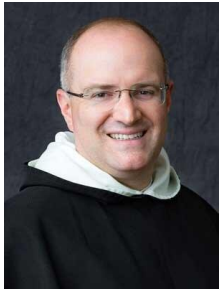
## REMINDER: SINGLE USE ONLY

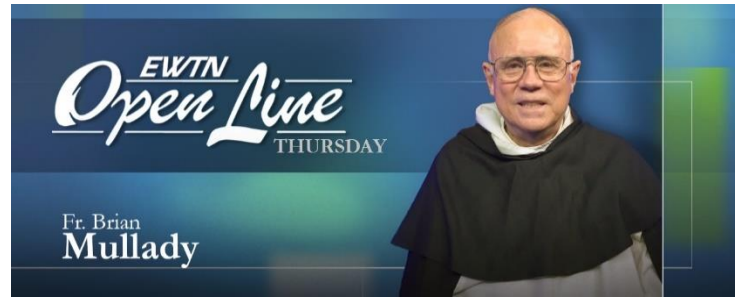
## WISE HABITS: 30 MINUTES WITH DSPT SCHOLARS

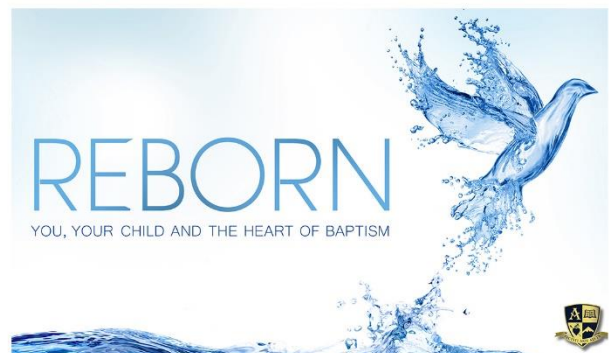
