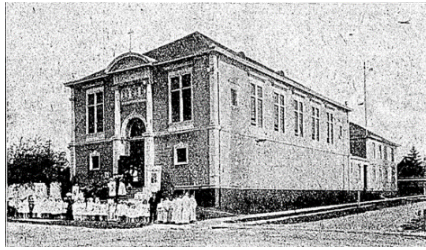

WHAT: This live online interactive workshop series will help you learn to navigate any abortion conversation with grace. Learn from expert dialogue artists in a safe environment. You won't be put on the spot, but we will give you interactive role-play exercises to complete so that you can "learn by doing." JFA trainers will respond to your questions in each session. Use our step-by-step instructions to experience the thrill of creating a productive conversation with at least one pro-choice advocate within one week of the end of the workshop series.

WHEN: Beginning January 18, 2021, JFA is offering eight convenient options, allowing you to complete the 7-hour training in 7 weeks, 1 week, or 1 day.

WHY: Unborn children and their mothers are depending on you and me to help create thousands of conversations in everyday life, conversations that are essential for changing public opinion and, ultimately, public policy.

COST: Free

NOTE: This is the same great training we offered in 2020

under the name "7 Conversations in 7 Hours." The new name, Love3, is shorter and refers to the goal of a good conversation: to actively love the woman, the child, and the person with whom we're speaking equally at every moment of the conversation.

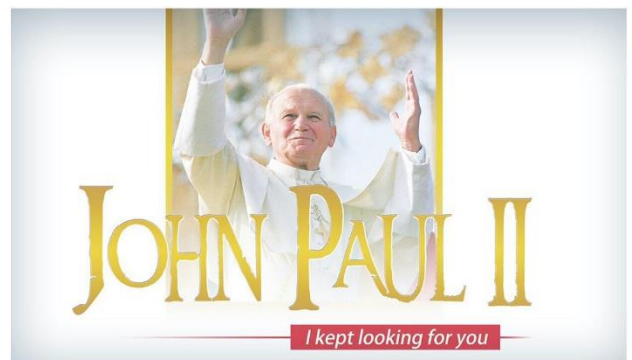
