## Dear Parishioners:

This week I was speaking to one of my relatives who belongs to an Evangelical Church up in the Seattle area. He was excited that their congregation was celebrating a ten-year anniversary. Ten years! Is that so? The edges of my lips curled upward ever so slightly in a smile with this thought. I kept the knowledge that Holy Rosary, our parish, was celebrating its 127th anniversary of founding to myself!

While Holy Rosary has been in existence for more than one and a quarter century, it's really just a regional instantiation of the Universal Catholic Church, founded by Jesus Christ. In other words, our Church is approximately 2,000 years old, but we as a worship community in NE Portland have been doing so continuously since 1894. Clearly, our special communal relationship isn't defined by me, my staff at this time, nor is it even defined by the Dominicans of the Western Dominican Province. Rather, it's our relationship to our Trinitarian God in our physical church, blessed so many years ago by his Excellency, Archbishop William Gross, C.S.S.R.

If the walls could speak, I'm certain we could fill volumes with stories, both happy and sad, of the families that have grown up in our humble parish. We have certainly navigated through various world crises, not least of which were two world wars, a couple instances of civil unrest, and various pandemics, the latest of which is the corona variant. And while I do long for the days when we can have a proper celebration, i.e., a celebration that includes food, fun, conversation, and kids laughing and at play in the hall, it does seem like we've turned a corner. At least we can come together to worship almost as before. Please continue to pray for our community, our state, our nation, and the world in which live, and that we will continue to thrive through the next century.

Don't forget that we will be blessing candles at all of the Masses for the Feast of the Presentation/Purification on Tuesday, February 2nd. Cantores in Ecclesia sing at the 7:00p Dominican Rite Mass. You are encouraged to bring your candles from home. The tradition of blessing candles on this feast stems from the prophetic fulfillment to Simeon: Mary and Joseph bring the infant Jesus to the Temple as "A light to the revelation of the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel." Because Christ is light, we bless candles to be used throughout the year. At home this might be for prayer vigils, meals, or other family gatherings, such as the recitation of the Rosary.

## LOVE3 WORKSHOPS: LEARN TO NAVIGATE ABORTION CONVERSATIONS IN A SAFE ENVIRONMENT

Justice for All's Love3 Workshops begin next week. Sign up now at [jfaweb.org/love3](http://jfaweb.org/love3)! Here's a snapshot so you know the basics:

**WHO:** Christians and other pro-life advocates, ages 12 and up\* (Pro-choice advocates and those unsure of what they think about legal abortion are also very welcome!)

**WHAT:** This live online interactive workshop series will help you learn to navigate any abortion conversation with grace. Learn from expert dialogue artists in a safe environment. You won't be put on the spot, but we will give you interactive role-play exercises to complete so that you can "learn by doing." JFA trainers will respond to your questions in each session. Use our step-by-step instructions to experience the thrill of creating a productive conversation with at least one pro-choice advocate within one week of the end of the workshop series.

**WHEN:** Beginning January 18, 2021, JFA is offering eight convenient options, allowing you to complete the 7-hour training in 7 weeks, 1 week, or 1 day.

**WHY:** Unborn children and their mothers are depending on you and me to help create thousands of conversations in everyday life, conversations that are essential for changing public opinion and, ultimately, public policy.

**COST:** Free

**NOTE:** This is the same great training we offered in 2020 under the name "7 Conversations in 7 Hours." The new name, Love3, is shorter and refers to the goal of a good conversation: to actively love the woman, the child, and the person with whom we're speaking equally at every moment of the conversation.

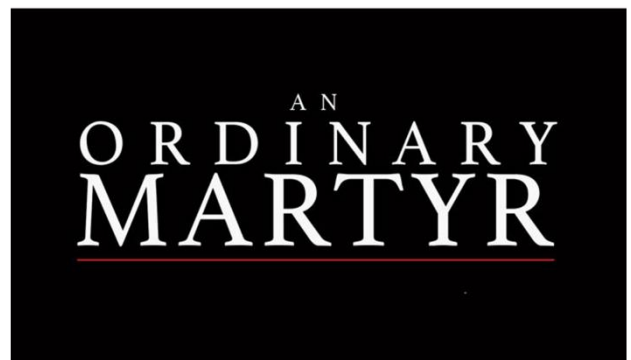
