Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

The Latin word for darkness is *tenebrae*. For language geeks it is a 1st declension plural feminine noun. But for religious communities and cathedral chapters it is a liturgical service that spans the three days of the Sacred Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. Essentially, they are an expanded "hour" of the Divine Office which combines the Office of Matins and the Office of Lauds. Because we Dominicans are a religious community, each and every year we pray the *Tenebrae* liturgy.

Tenebrae has a two-fold meaning. It is traditionally chanted in darkness, typically before sunrise. It also hearkens to the time of the destruction of the First Temple in Jerusalem and the beginning of the time of captivity in Babylon (c. 586 BC). The entire Book of Lamentations is devoted to this heart-wrenching event. Thus, the "lessons" chanted during *Tenebrae* come directly from these scriptures. Holy Week is a unique time of year because we enter into the Lord's Passion and *Tenebrae* is a time to be in union with him. Like Israel, who lose both their land and their temple, we too lose Jesus to his Passion and death.

At Holy Rosary, we will chant psalms and lessons at 8:00a on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. We Dominicans invite all parishioners and their friends to join us in the hauntingly beautiful service. For continuity's sake it's best to come to all three, but if that is not possible, please join us for *Tenebrae* on Saturday, where we will sing the *Prayer of Jeremiah*, the last chapter from the Book of Lamentations. All Lay Dominicans should make an effort to attend.

Throughout the year, most parishioners come to Holy Rosary just on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. But I encourage you all to take advantage of this week to attend the Evening Services of the Mass of the Lord's Supper (Holy Thursday), the Veneration of the Cross (Good Friday), and the Easter Vigil (Holy Saturday). These liturgies are by far are the most important. But, if you have the opportunity, or if you'd like to get a peek into Dominican prayer, please come to *Tenebrae* as well. You will not likely forget it.
