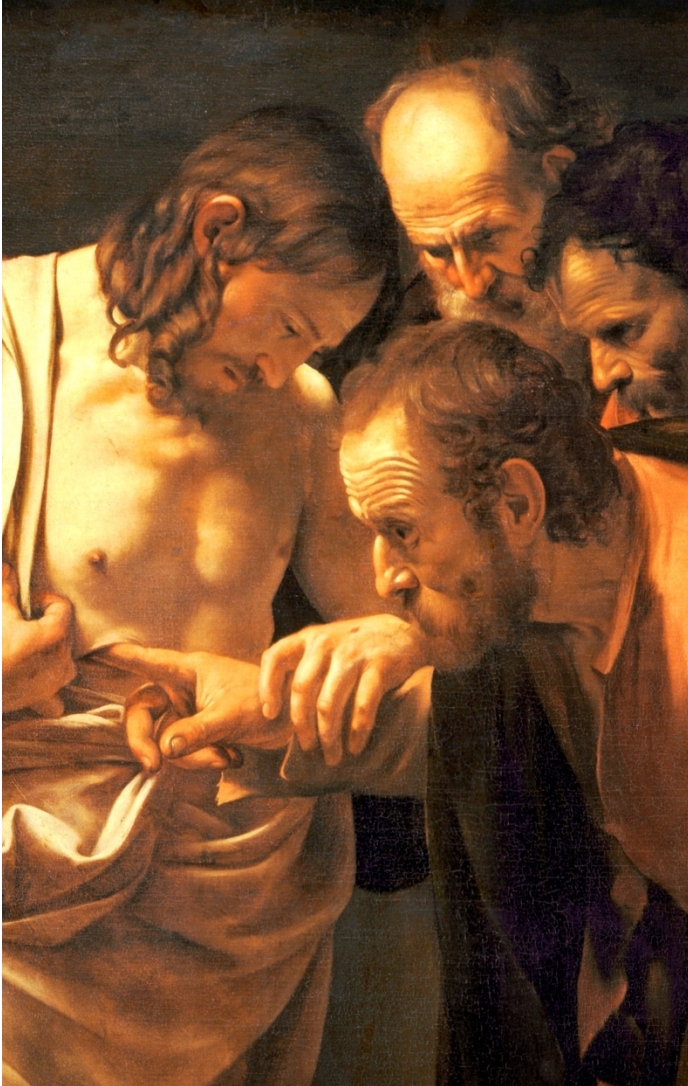

Dear Parishioners:

When the malformed child was found at the Monastery door he was named by those monks after the first word of the Introit of Mass on that very day. The character of Quasimodo is a tragic figure that Victor Hugo employs to articulate his commentary on human nature. We are all similar to Quasimodo who was deprived of his own mother's milk as an infant and so he seeks for his consolations in the memory of what he has never had, yet yearns to possess. The yearning brings about great suffering and confusion in his life. Yet, he is ever drawn toward the sort of kindness that comes from authentic Christian love. That introit speaks about how we all yearn like infants for the spiritual milk that our Holy Mother, the Church, ministers to each of us by way of her mission.

This day was also historically the day that the white garments worn by those Christians who had been newly baptized on Easter Sunday would be removed and deposited in the church. Just like the poor foundling Quasimodo we ourselves were adopted into the divine family knowing that we were starving in our spirit for the food that only God can provide. Now having partaken of the great feast, the time comes for regularity to set in so that we can make the transformative event of conversion into the normative progress of a Christian life well lived.

This Sunday, Quasimodo Sunday, is the day for us to recall the great work that Christ has done for us as we share in the true milk of the Spirit that we are continuously provided in our lives. As we tap into that spiritual nourishment more perfectly, we are able to fight against the temptations of this world more easily so that we can be greater witnesses to others. We are abandoned and foundlings no longer, we are not children of tragedy. We are the redeemed. We belong to the Lamb who was slain for us and we must resolve to live our lives for Him alone.
