*Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,*

Today we have the Octave of Easter, which has been known throughout the centuries by other names: *Missa in albis* is one, alluding to a second group of baptisms the ancient Church would celebrate today, with all the newly baptized clothed in white (*albus* in Latin) garments. It was also called Low Sunday, following the higher celebration of Easter Day.

In recent decades, with the spread of the Divine Mercy devotion, we also call today Divine Mercy Sunday, a title which has been solemnized by use in the current Roman Missal. Our Lord Himself asked this feast to be established for the Church. To the Polish nun, St. Faustina Kowalska, He appeared in the 1930's asking that she be His instrument in founding this feast for the Church.

And Our Lord's message to her was one of urging all people to trust in His mercy and His desire to forgive sins, which comes to us through the sacraments:

*My heart overflows with great mercy for souls, and especially for poor sinners. If only they could understand that I am the best of Fathers to them and that it is for them that the Blood and Water flowed from My Heart as from a fount overflowing with mercy. For them I dwell in the tabernacle as King of Mercy (Diary of St. Faustina, 367).*

And what Our Lord promised for this feast would be an extraordinary cleansing from sin, and all the temporal punishment due to sin. All who fulfill the requirements of celebrating Divine Mercy Sunday will be brought back to that state of purity and innocence when they first came out of the Baptismal font. They will be freed from all the punishment they would have to endure in purgatory because of past sins.

So, all are encouraged to take advantage of Our Lord's extraordinary mercy today. In order to do so we are asked:

- to have gone to confession in the past 10 days;
- to receive Holy Communion on Sunday, as we normally do;
- to make sure that we are giving up all our habits of sin, even venial sin—that our hearts are not still clinging to sin in any form;
- to say an Our Father and Apostle's Creed for the Pope;
- And finally, to participate in Divine Mercy service, or to pray before the Blessed Sacrament, adoring the great mercy of our Savior.

Our Lord assuring us on this day *that all the floodgates through which graces flow to the world are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or angel, will be able to fathom it throughout eternity (699).*
