Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

Χριστός Ανέστη! Αληθώς ανέστη! “Christ is Risen.” “Truly, He is Risen.” This is the traditional Easter greeting given between acquaintances in the Greek community on Easter Sunday. While Jesus himself spoke Aramaic and Latin it’s unclear if he ever spoke Greek (though it had more to do with lack of occasions than because of any deficiencies in his Divine Nature). Nevertheless, Christians throughout the world have adopted this particular proclamation and response in many languages. Of course in English it can have many variations. I personally learned it as “Christ is Risen. He is Risen indeed.” They all work.

Note that the verb “is” in the present and not “has” or “had” in the past. Scripture, after all, refers to the event in the past, and not in the present. So, why is there a difference? Well, scripture is referring to events chronologically as narratives often do. Sometimes we speak in the historical present, but when we want recount events that have already occurred, we need to speak about them in the past. But to say that Christ is Risen speaks of a more theological reality. To us he is risen, and it speaks to the role that Christ has for us personally. While he rose for all humanity, for us as individuals calls to mind our own personal salvation, hinged on our cooperation. What an incredible gift!

Like many greetings and interactions, we sometimes say them without thinking. Thus they become rote and meaningless. Or, we take the expression for granted—kind of like “how’s it going?”, where we’re not really asking a question, but merely saying “hi.” This Easter, when we say, “Christ is Risen” or we respond with “Truly, He is Risen” let us contemplate on the immense grace that God has bestowed on us. Eternal life is not to be taken lightly. Let us make ourselves worthy to receive it.
