Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

This weekend, we celebrate Palm Sunday, also known as Passion Sunday. It marks the beginning of Holy Week and commemorates Jesus Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem. The instructions for the liturgy for Palm Sunday vary depending on whether we celebrate the Roman or Dominican rite here at Holy Rosary, but here are a few things to remember:

Blessing and Distribution of Palms: In the Roman rite, the liturgy begins at the back of the church with the distribution and blessing of palms. The ushers will distribute the palms. The priest will then bless the palm branches, inviting the faithful to "hold high these branches to hail Christ in his triumph, [and] bear fruit by good works accomplished in him." While the faithful hold the branches aloft in their hands, the priest sprinkles the branches with holy water. In the Dominican rite, the priest will bless the palm branches before Mass begins. After the blessing, the congregation will come up to the altar rail to receive the palms, then return to the pews for the reading of the Gospel account of Our Lord's entry into Jerusalem and a procession of the ministers. Mass will follow the procession.

At all the Masses, it is important to remember that because the palms are blessed, they are now sacramentals, sacred signs instituted by the Church, "bearing a resemblance to the sacraments. They signify effects, particularly of a spiritual nature, which are obtained through the intercession of the Church." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1667) Please do not leave them on the floor or throw them away into the trash. The Directory on Popular Piety and Liturgy reminds us that palm branches are to be kept in the home as a witness to faith in Jesus Christ, the messianic king, and in his Paschal Victory (139).

The Passion Reading: In the Roman rite, the Passion narrative will be sung or read by three persons who take the part of Christ, the narrator, and the people. At the vigil, 7 am, and 5:30 pm Sunday Masses, the priest, the lector, and the congregation will read the Passion narrative. The faithful are invited to take part in the narrative by taking out the Pew Missal, turning to page 125, then following along and responding to the parts of the "Chorus" and "Speaker". At the 9 am Roman rite and 11 am Dominican rite Masses, the friars and the choir will sing all of the parts of the Passion narrative.
