God be praised for his mercies!

Divine Mercy Sunday always falls on the Second Sunday of the Easter. We can thank St. John Paul II for that when he canonized Sister Faustina Kowalska in the year 2000. From St. Faustina we get a beautiful description of the mercy of God. She describes how God desires to flood us with the ocean of His mercy. It is a font that does not run dry.

The Second Sunday of Easter is part of the Octave of Easter. The first eight days of the season are considered as one whole day in the liturgical calendar. As Sunday is to the week, so is the Octave of Easter to the year.

On this Sunday, let us be reminded of the opening prayers from Mass invoking the mercies of God:

*God of everlasting mercy,
who in the very recurrence of the paschal feast
kindle the faith of the people you have made your own,
increase, we pray, the grace you have bestowed,
that all may grasp and rightly understand
in what font they have been washed,
by whose Spirit they have been reborn,
by whose Blood they have been redeemed.*
