Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

It is my pleasure to announce that we are working on an agreement to host the Chesterton Academy of Bl. Pier Giorgio Frassati (OP) here at Holy Rosary come Fall 2022. It is a high school that uses a classical liberal arts curriculum and has been getting rave reviews throughout the country and even boasts some international locations. I've actually been researching this for the last two years, having visited multiple campuses. And, I know the founder personally. Because a significant part of their curriculum involves daily Mass, instruction in sacred music, and involvement in the church, from my perspective it has few downsides.

Naturally, fitting an entirely new group into our physical space will have a couple of challenges, but they are not insurmountable. They will occupy only portions of Aquinas Hall, which is at present woefully underutilized. The Western Dominican Province and Holy Rosary Parish are committed to their first year of existence with a desire that we can extend it indefinitely.

Recall that Aquinas Hall had previously operated as a school, though it was well before my time. Since then it has been an events hall, office space, and transitional storage—none of which contribute to the mission of the Church nor the salvation of souls. It has been my desire that we return it to its original purpose. So, this is exciting news indeed.

REPLACEMENT LIVESTREAM CAMERA

We determined that the live streaming camera in situ is insufficient for our use here at Holy Rosary. It is overly dark, blurry, and we don't have control over the framing/scene features that we'd like (focus on ambo, congregation, altar, etc). Unfortunately, there's quite a big jump in cost between the entry-level camera that we have and one that would meet our needs. Therefore, if there is a benefactor that would like to donate or partially contribute to the cost of the new camera and materials we would be immensely grateful. The differential in cost is about \$10,000. Some might ask why this is necessary given the waning of the pandemic. However, we have a fairly large community of parishioners that can no longer physically come to Mass and this gives them a link to our community. In addition, these cameras can help us record special events throughout the year. Please contact the office for more information.
