## Dear Parishioners:

To say that we're back with a bang is a gross understatement. For example, this past Saturday we, in conjunction with our Young Adults, our Youth, the Knights of Columbus, and the Urban Missionaries, completed our first Stations of the Cross through the streets of Portland. It was awesome! Br. John Paul reminded us all that this was foremost for us, the uniting of our bodies and souls to the suffering of Christ in his Passion. At times it was hot, at times we encountered some mocking and belittling, and at times there were obstacles. Yet, they were but minuscule compared to those of our Lord—giving us cause to reflect on what are real challenges in our relatively comfortable lives.

Still, it was an experience not-to-be-missed. All of us got an up-close peek of the unpleasant underbelly of the living conditions of the homeless on one end of the spectrum, and the somewhat carefree, if not aloof, attitude of those in the Saturday Market and at public fountains. As with the actual Via Dolorosa in Jerusalem, there were parts that were a crowded affair. We were able to successfully navigate through the scores of people and be witnesses of our precious Catholic Faith. I'm certain that no soul went unaffected, even if it was the tiniest of planting of seeds.

I look forward to the next time that we can gather to once again bring the Stations of the Cross to the streets, activated by the grace of our Confirmation. There is a certain safety in numbers for certain. But more importantly, there is the common mission of evangelization to bring the Faith to Portland, which like many cities, has been disaffected by fear, loneliness, isolation, and in desperate need for the Love of Christ. In the meanwhile, we're cooking up many more activities to strengthen our resolve and our community. So stay tuned...
