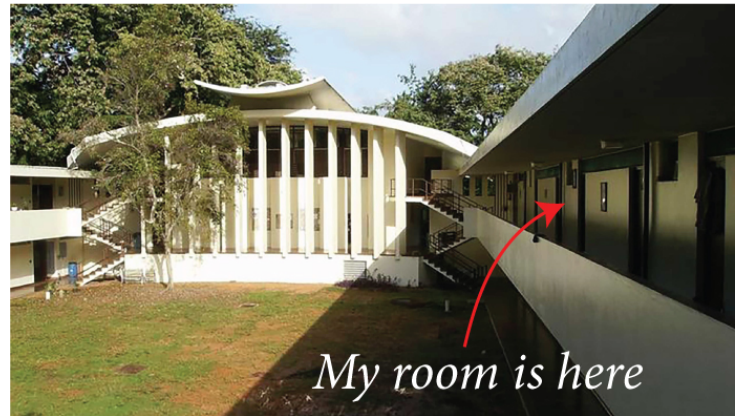

Dear Parishioners:



My room is here

After some 14 hours of land and air travel, the first thing I had hoped to do when I arrived to Puerto Rico was to find myself a hot shower. Fray Jaime picked me up and we headed straight to the Dominican friars' house named *Convento Santo Rosario*, which just happens to translate as Holy Rosary Convent. That makes our parishes known as *tocayos* — a Spanish word used to describe people with the same name. After putting my things down in my room and Fray Jaime explained to me how the hot water sometimes works, depending on the day, and the rotation of various knobs, and the alignment of the stars... alas! I have yet to figure out how to access the hot water. But when the lows are consistently in the mid-70s, it turns out it's not so bad!

We Dominicans minister in two locations on the island. Currently I am in Bayamón, which is a part of the greater San Juan region in the northeast. Here we cover three parishes (*Parroquia Invenición de Santa Cruz* — Discovery of the Holy Cross, *Parroquia Nuestra Señora del Perpetuo Socorro* — Our Lady of Perpetual Help, *Parroquia Santo Domingo de Guzmán* — St. Dominic de Guzmán) as well as the *Santuario Nacional de San Martín de Porres* — National Shrine of St. Martin de Porres. In addition, the Dominican friars in the 1960s founded and still teach and help staff the *Universidad Central de Bayamón* and a primary school *Academia Santo Tomás*.

Towards the end of December, I am scheduled to help out in the second location with our Dominicans in Yauco (southwest part of the island). In Yauco we have a parish also named *Santísimo Rosario* — Most Holy Rosary — which also includes 11 (ELEVEN) chapels in the surrounding foothills. My room neighbor Fray Gregorio makes the 2-1/2 hour drive one-way to Yauco every weekend to help cover those sites. I look forward to joining him.
