Dear Parishioners:

From the Life of Saint Thomas Aquinas

St. Thomas Aquinas is considered a powerhouse figure in the history of the Church. He was a brilliant man and one of the most prolific writers the Church has ever known... Yet he was humbled while celebrating Mass on December 6, 1273, on the Feast of St. Nicholas. Witnesses recalled that he became utterly dumbstruck with awe by what happened to the elements of the bread and wine and their transubstantiation into the Body and Blood of Jesus. He was so overcome that he simply sat down and could not finish the Mass.

He would later remark that he considered all that he had written to be like straw compared to what was revealed to him in that moment. And afterward, he stopped writing. He did not complete his great work of the *Summa Theologiae* - his followers and students finished it for him. One of the Church's greatest thinkers who helped synthesize and systematize the entire corpus of theology was overwhelmed by the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

And we still have the real presence of Jesus among us. He is present in every tabernacle in every one of our churches. Let us ask the Lord to help us in any moments of unbelief.

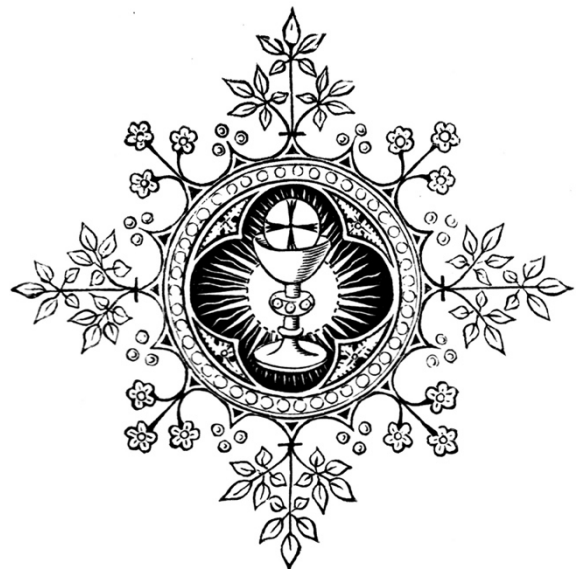
PRESIDENT'S DAY
