Jesus says to his disciples: "Take care not to perform righteous deeds in order that people may see them; otherwise, you will have no recompense from your heavenly Father."

With that warning, there is also a challenge:

If you have no intention of making a good confession during Lent, then don't receive the ashes.

If you have no intention of observing the disciplines of abstinence and fasting during Lent, then don't receive the ashes.

If you have no intention of attending Mass until Easter, then don't receive the ashes.

If your principal desire to receive the ashes is so that you can post it on your social media, then better for you to not.

Else, these ashes will be a source of vanity and pride; or worse - hypocrisy.

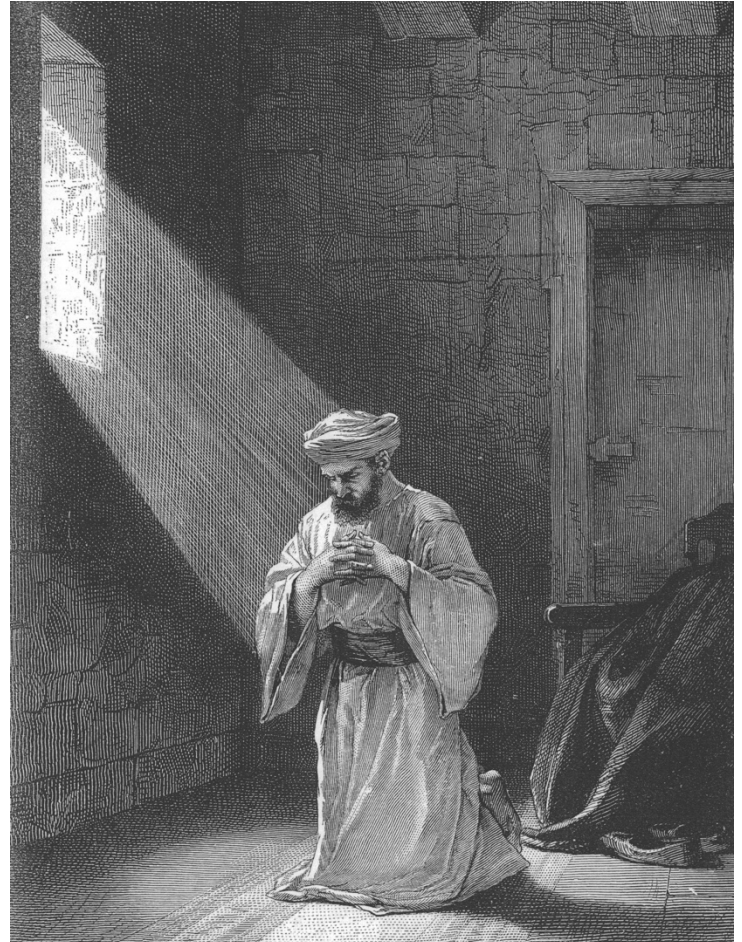
