Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

Thank you to everyone who made last week's celebration of Holy Rosary's 130th anniversary dedication a success! Thank you to all the musicians, ministers, servers, and ushers who assisted with the liturgy, music, and flowers. I also want to thank the Knights of Columbus for preparing and cooking breakfast after each of the morning masses.

This year, Lent will begin on February 14th with Ash Wednesday. Each year, the ashes used on Ash Wednesday are from the burning of the blessed palms distributed on the previous Palm Sunday. In preparation for this year's Ash Wednesday, I kindly request that you bring your old blessed palms to the church vestibule. There will be a basket present where you can leave the blessed palms. The burning of these palms symbolizes a circle of faith and penitence. It reminds us of the transient nature of life and the call to repentance and conversion as we hear the words, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return," while receiving the ashes.

To help us enter into the spirit of Lent, Holy Rosary Church will host a Lenten Mission with Fr. Brian Mullady, O.P., a member of our local priory and a renowned theologian and professor. Fr. Brian has appeared on Mother Angelica's EWTN television network. He is a prolific author, having written numerous books and articles, and a contributor to the Answer column in the Homiletic and Pastoral Review. Pope Francis appointed him as an official Missionary of Mercy.

This mission, centered on the theme of "The Three Ages of the Spiritual Life," promises to be an enriching experience for all as we journey through the Lenten season. He will preach at all weekend Masses on the 17th and 18th of February, offering his insights and reflections to commence the Lenten journey. Then, he will give a series of talks at 7 PM each night in the church from Monday to Thursday (February 19 - 22). These presentations will guide us through the stages of spiritual life and growth. I invite all parishioners and visitors to join us for this unique opportunity to deepen our faith and understanding of the spiritual journey during this sacred season of Lent.
