

Dear Parishioners:

St. Paul teaches us in today's second reading that each of us has a necessary function in the Body. No two of us are alike, no two functions in the Body are alike. We are each called to a time, and a place, and for a purpose. To God we are each a unique person, a unique reflection of his image and likeness, an integral part of the Body of Christ. He created each of us to have a particular role.

When we hear this reading about how the eye needs the body and the body needs the eye, the ear needs the body and the body needs the ear, and so forth, we ask ourselves, "So what is my function in the body? What is it that I have to offer?"

The reading presents an image of the Body of Christ in a social context, manifested in the living out of our lives. St. Paul even gives us some concrete examples. He says some are prophets, some are apostles, some healers, some teachers, etc. We can add to this list: mothers, fathers, priests, artists, carpenters, care givers, service men and women. Some are journalists, others protectors of legal rights. Some design buildings, others build them. All are different.

Our vocations in this life are varied, as we have listed. Whether at home in the family, studying at our schools, at the workplace or markets, each in our own ways we sanctify the world by doing the will of God for us. Together we make God's plan a reality. Together we make up the Body of Christ both here on Earth and in Heaven.

January 29 | 11:00 AM




