Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,
 Happy New Year! May the blessing of peace, joy, and love of the Holy Family be with your family in this new year. I pray that our Holy Rosary community will grow in faith, be confirmed in hope, and united in love this year and the years ahead.

In this month of January, we continue with the Christmas Season, and then return to Ordinary Time. The Christmas season, represented in white - the color of light, and symbol of joy and chastity - celebrates the mystery of the Incarnation. During these days, we continue to joyfully celebrate the mystery of the birth of the Lord in Bethlehem and in our hearts, especially the Solemnity of Mary as the Mother of God and the Feast of the Epiphany. The Christmas season ends with the Feast of the Baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist.

The remaining days of January are in Ordinary Time, represented in green. Green is a symbol of hope, for it is the color of the seed that is germinating and awakening in the believer the hope of reaping an eternal harvest in heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection. Towards the last Sunday in January, we will celebrate the external solemnity of the dedication of Holy Rosary Church. Please plan on joining other parishioners after Mass in Siena Hall for brunch.

Also, as some of you know, Fr. Paul and I will be away for much of January to attend the Provincial Chapter of the Western Dominican Province. The chapter occurs every four years, where we Dominicans gather to elect our prior provincial, then discuss and plan the next four years. Please keep us in your prayers, so that we can make wise decisions.
