Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

The month of January is dedicated to the Most Holy Name of Jesus. The veneration and devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus emphasize the power and significance of Jesus' name, and its roots can be traced back to the New Testament, where the importance of Jesus' name is frequently highlighted (e.g., Philippians 2:9-11). The Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus, celebrated on January 3rd each year, was closely associated with the Circumcision of Jesus, traditionally observed on January 1st, eight days after His birth, following Jewish custom. Jesus was officially given His name during this event, as narrated in the Gospel of Luke (Luke 2:21). Hence, it is fitting that January, the month when this significant event is commemorated, is dedicated to the Holy Name.

The name of Jesus, meaning "God saves" in Hebrew, encapsulates Christ's mission and identity. The name not only symbolizes one's identity but also one's mission. By dedicating January to the Holy Name of Jesus, the Church encourages us to start the new year with a renewed focus on Christ, invoking His name in prayer and reflecting on its profound meaning. The Western Dominican Province, also formally known as the Province of the Most Holy Name of Jesus, invites us to share in the mission of the salvation of souls to a secular culture in the Western United States. Here at Holy Rosary, let us pray in the Holy Name of Jesus for peace, holiness, and good health in the new year.
