Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

Although the Easter Season has officially ended (the final feast was with Pentecost), many people might not be able to recognize the signs—well, because they're not necessarily obvious. For those of us who assist at daily Mass, the vestments have returned to green—the color of Ordinary (ordered) Time, or the Time after Pentecost (in the older calendars). Some churches put up green accents in the sanctuary. But here at Holy Rosary we rely simply on vestment color. But for those people that typically come to liturgies just on Sundays, they won't see green for a few more weeks. That's because there are many upcoming feasts of Our Lord.

The first Sunday after Pentecost is The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, which shows us the outpouring of love between the persons of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The second Sunday after Pentecost is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, which shows us the outpouring of love of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Within that same week, but on Friday, we have the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart, which clearly shows the outpouring of love of Jesus to all of humanity.

While Easter and Pentecost are most definitely historical events in the chronology of salvation history, these post-Pentecost feasts represent the ongoing love that God has for his people. As we travel through this period we must recall that we are called to imitate this ongoing love, not just to God, but also to our neighbor. Let us not use this time just as a remembrance of the acts of others, but indeed to incorporate acts of this love towards others in our own lives.
