

Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

It is good to see so many more people coming to confession this Lent. The friars have noticed, however, that these confessions sometimes continue well into the Mass time. Once the time for Mass begins, the focus shifts to the celebration of the Eucharist, and the liturgy becomes the center of focus.

In general, it is customary for confessions to end before Mass begins. Confession is usually offered before Mass, giving the faithful the opportunity to confess their sins and receive absolution. In some churches, there may be an opportunity for individual confessions during Mass, such as during the Penitential Rite or the Liturgy of the Word. However, this would typically be indicated in the order of service or by the presiding priest. At Holy Rosary, we have decided that confessions will end when Mass begins.

A few other important factors to consider when preparing for confession are the following:

- 1. Examination of conscience: Before going to confession, take some time to examine your conscience and reflect on your sins of commission and omission. Be specific when confessing your sins. State the type of sin and how many times you committed it.
- 2. Sincerity: Confess your sins, including those that are difficult or embarrassing to talk about. Remember that the priest is there to help and guide you.
- 3. Contrition: Ask for forgiveness and make a firm resolution to avoid these sins in the future. Don't fall into the sin of presumption, and abuse God's gift of mercy.
- 4. Humility: Approach the sacrament of confession with humility, recognizing that you are a sinner in need of God's mercy. Avoid making excuses or blaming others for your sins.
- 5. Absolution: After confessing your sins, listen attentively to the priest's advice and penance. Accept the penance as a means of making amends for your sins and growing in holiness.

Finally, a few parishioners have inquired about Fr. Paschal. Fr. Paschal used to help with confessions for many years. Due to a fall recently, he will not be able to assist with confessions anymore. If you would like visit Fr. Paschal, please speak with me, and I will ask him for a convenient time to visit. Please keep our beloved Fr. Paschal in your prayers.
