Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

March is traditionally the month of St. Joseph, with the principal feast day falling on March 19th. This is because of St. Joseph's role as the foster father of Jesus Christ and the husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Holy Rosary will celebrate this great saint, intercessor, and protector of the universal church with our annual St. Joseph Men's Dinner. I want to invite all men--fathers, godfathers, sons, brothers, uncles, grandpas - in our community to this fun evening filled with food and a talk on St. Joseph. It will be on Saturday, March 23, 2024, from 6:30 PM - 7:30 PM. Please RSVP to office@holyrosarypdx.org by March 17<sup>th</sup> so that we can prepare enough food. We will provide Bratwurst sausages, beer, root beer, hoagie rolls, sides, and fixings.

In March, let us practice the virtues of humility, diligence, and obedience to God's will, as exemplified by St. Joseph, and seek his intercession and protection in our lives, family, and Church community. Devotion to St. Joseph will help us foster a deeper connection to the Holy Family and develop a profound appreciation for the model of sanctity that St. Joseph provides for all men.

This month, our parish church is also blessed to have an icon of the Fruits of the Passion next to the statue of St. Joseph. In the vestibule and the back of the church, we have some information to help parishioners and visitors reflect on the many fruits of Christ's passion. I invite us all to reflect on the fruits of our Lord's passion. And for this Sunday, the fourth Sunday of Lent, we celebrate Laetare Sunday, which is a midpoint in the Lenten season. The name "Laetare" comes from the Latin word for "rejoice," taken from the introit of the day's Mass, "Laetare Jerusalem" ("Rejoice, O Jerusalem"). This Sunday is similar in purpose to Gaudete Sunday during Advent; both provide a moment of gratitude within a season of preparation and penance. This Sunday offers a break in the Lenten austerity, symbolizing hope and encouragement as Easter approaches. It reminds us of the joy to come and reminds us of the Christian fruit of resurrection and renewal.

Finally, on a personal note, I will be away for the Dominican superiors' annual meeting at Villa Maria del Mar in Santa Cruz, California, this week. The meeting will last from Monday to Thursday and will discuss the needs and assignments of our ministries. I ask for your prayers for a fruitful meeting, for all the friars of the Western Province, especially our frail and retired friars, and for the needs of our parish community.
