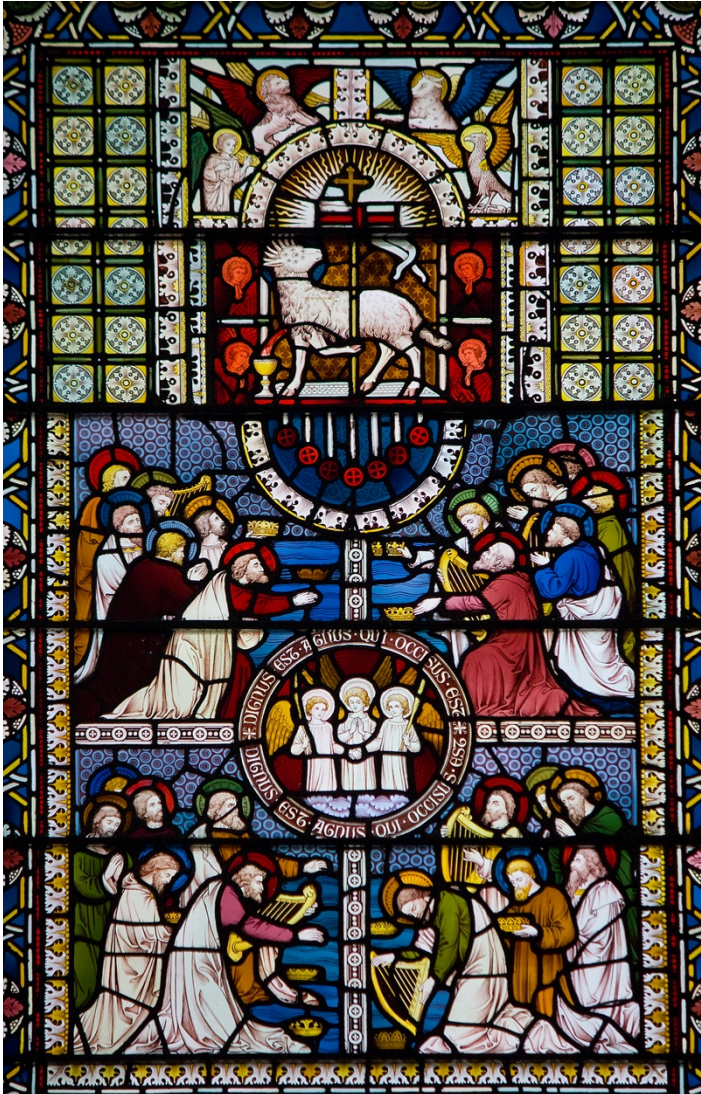

## Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

There's a popular story involving Mother Teresa and one of her sisters in the Missionaries of Charity. Many of you have heard it from me the in the past. But like all good stories, it bears repeating.

In Calcutta at their mission site the Sisters were once overwhelmed with the number of people that needed their assistance. As most of us know, the MCs (as they are fondly known) minister to the "poorest of the poor," often in urban slums and other "undesirable" places. No matter what they did they just couldn't "keep up." A Sister approached Mother in search of a solution, to which Mother pondered for a bit and then responded with, "let's add more prayer to our schedule."

What?!? Obviously, by increasing prayer time would naturally decrease the amount of time that they could use for ministerial acts. Mother explained that by increasing their prayer God would provide for their needs. As it turned out, she was correct. Providentially, the Sisters were somehow able to, through the Work of the Holy Spirit, accomplish more and provide more care to those who needed it. This is not just an interesting and pious story. Indeed, God showers us with graces the more we pay attention to Him.

I recount this story for a good reason. Lately the number of people that have shown up to our weekly Adoration and Benediction on Wednesday evenings (7p-8p) has fallen off. There are still regulars, of course. But I know there are plenty of lost opportunities. Recently I was at a chapel elsewhere that had evening adoration. A family of 6 were already there: 4 kids all under the age of 6! The active teaching of children the importance of prayer and adoration is paramount. It cannot just be explained, but rather experienced. Yes, they will be fussy and noisy on occasion. But, recognizing the presence of God in the Sacrament is an important lesson. Certainly, kids have bedtimes and schedules, but occasionally we interrupt them for the greater good. And what greater good is there? Can we expect our teenagers to fall into prayer if they don't already know how to do? Speaking of which, we also have youth adoration monthly on second Fridays.
