Dear Parishioners:

"Faith and reason are like two wings on which the human spirit rises to the contemplation of truth." - Pope St. John Paul II, *Fides et Ratio*.

We are a people of both Faith and Reason - Fides (faith) et Ratio (reason). Reason can get us quite a ways. Faith can get us even further.

It is by faith that we proclaim God as a Trinity. When it comes to the Doctrine of the Trinity, the Trinity is simply beyond reason. No matter how you cut it or by what angle you come at it or clever argumentation you propose, our rational minds cannot wrap around that God is Triune. Reason as we might, we fail to grasp completely the Most Holy Trinity with our limited minds.

Properly speaking, the trinitarian nature of God is given to us by divine revelation. It is part of the body of revealed truth from Scripture and Tradition and so belongs to the Depositum Fidei (Deposit of Faith). In other words, it is only by faith that we know God is a Trinity.

If we could rationalize God in all of his aspects, then we would likely put God in a box and then put that box on a back shelf in our minds and then eventually forget about Him. God will always remain a mystery on some level. And that's okay. We will have all eternity to contemplate Him in Heaven.

A useful image: Imagine a child attempting to hold an oversized ball with both arms trying to hug around it, but the child's lack of strength and grip and reach won't allow the ball to be held for more than a few seconds. That's us when we try to rationalize God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. I like to think that God laughs every time He escapes our comprehension of Him simply by doing nothing. "Aww, that was cute. And thanks for the hug."

THIS SUMMER we have the privilege to host a religious brother at Holy Rosary.



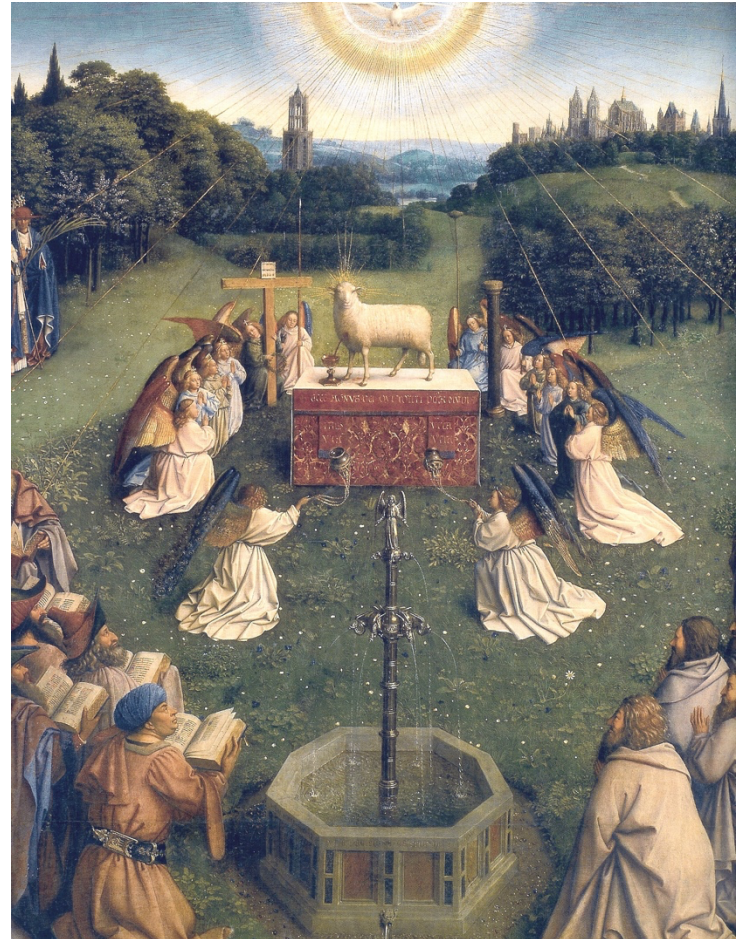
