

- we have recently expanded the security patrols to 24 hours a day,
- we have added patrols to the former dental building.
- we now have the ability to request emergency response from our patrol officers should the need arise,
- we diligently and repeatedly report "abandoned" cars and blocked walkways to the proper authorities.

We know these solutions are only a band-aid to the larger societal issues creating the safety and security challenges, but please know that we are committed to doing all we can to provide the safe and beautiful worship experience you expect from Holy Rosary.
