

This coming Tuesday, November 22nd, we have the feast of St. Cecilia, patroness of Church musicians and sacred music. A special Solemn High Mass will be celebrated that evening, with singing by Cantores in Ecclesia, honoring this great martyr and intercessor. That evening we will also recognize the invaluable contributions to sacred music of our own Choir Master, Dean Applegate, who will be retiring from many years of service at Holy Rosary. We are all deeply indebted to him and his decades-long promotion of the Church's great patrimony of liturgical music, both Gregorian Chant and sacred polyphony.

Back in 1983 Dean started the choir *Cantores in Ecclesia*, with the help of Bishop Paul Waldschmidt and the pastor at St. Patrick's church, Fr. Frank Knusel. Seeing the need for renewing the sacredness of the Holy Mass that had been, and continues to be, undermined by pop melodies and talk-show style liturgy, Dean dedicated himself not only to performing supremely beautiful music, but even more putting that music at the service of the liturgy. He has done for years such an impressive work for the parish and the entire Archdiocese. On numerous tours, Cantores also going beyond Portland to take the beauty of sacred music to other locations in the US and Europe.

Liturgical reform has progressed slowly but steadily through the past twenty years here in the Archdiocese, and in the Church at large. At the heart of it will always be the music that accompanies the liturgy. Our dispositions at Mass always depend on what is going on with our senses. When we are surrounded by secular melodies or images, our minds and hearts will drift quite naturally away from the sacred. Our Lord Himself makes this point in the Gospels: The eye is the lamp of the body. So, if your eye is sound, your whole body will be full of light; but if your eye is not sound, your whole body will be full of darkness (Mt. 6:22-23). The senses are the gateway to the soul and the whole person. Raising the soul to contemplate the mysteries of the faith requires music that guides us that direction. Gregorian chant and the music of artists like Palestrina, Byrd, and Tallis, arising from the beauty of chant, does just this. Speaking for the Fathers here at Holy Rosary, heart-felt thanks to you, Dean! And may God abundantly bless you for your dedication, many hidden sacrifices, and impressive perseverance in this all-important work of renewing Catholic worship.
