Dear Parishioners:

Saint Teresa of Avila wrote of St. Joseph: "Those who give themselves to prayer should in a special manner have always a devotion to St. Joseph; for I know not how any man can think of the Queen of the angels, during the time that she suffered so much with the Infant Jesus, without giving thanks to St. Joseph for the services he rendered them then." She also says of him: "To other saints, the Lord seems to have given grace to help us in some of our necessities. But my experience is that Saint Joseph helps us in them all!"

The Church encourages us to make use of the plenary indulgence available to us in this Year of St. Joseph. Note: The Year of St. Joseph ends on December 8, 2021, just two weeks from now.

The Plenary Indulgence is granted under the customary conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayers according to the Holy Father's intentions) to the faithful who, with a soul detached from any sin, shall participate in the Year of Saint Joseph, in at least one of the following pious acts:

- Entrust your daily work to the protection of St. Joseph the Worker.
- Meditate on the Lord's Prayer for 30 minutes.
- Have a retreat for at least one day, meditating on St.
- Perform a Corporal Work of Mercy or a Spiritual Work of Mercy.
- Pray a rosary with your family.
- Through the intercession of St. Joseph, pray that the unemployed will receive dignified work.
- Through the intercession of St. Joseph, pray for the relief of all Christians who suffer from persecution.
