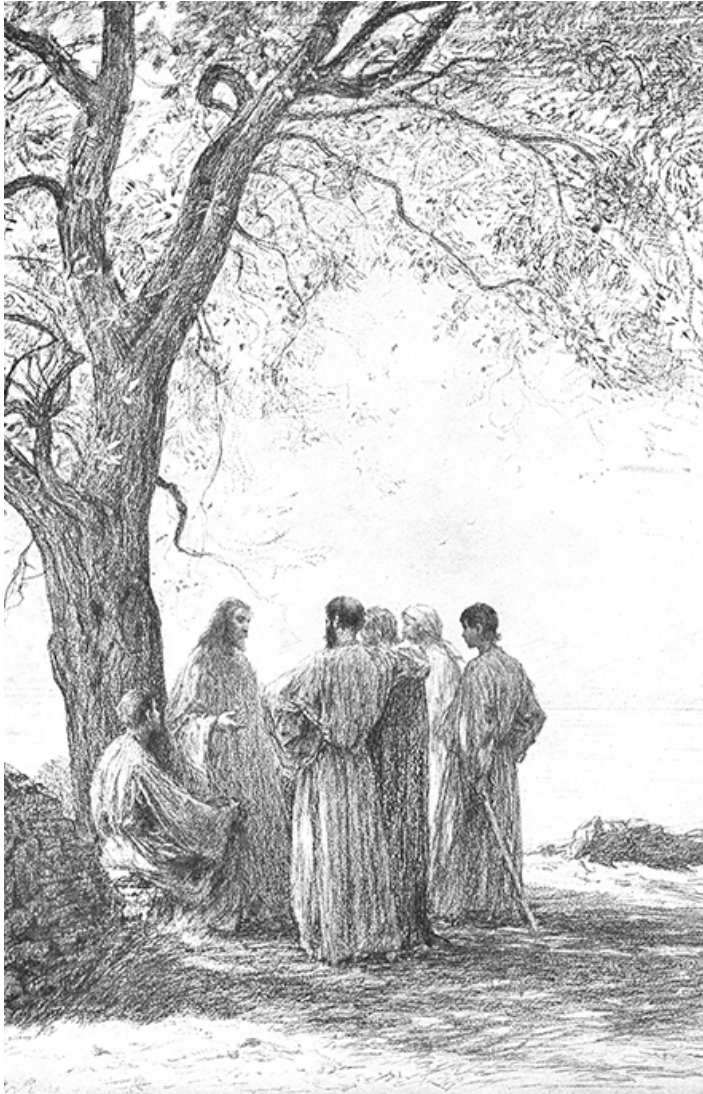

Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

October has two feasts that express the longstanding tradition of Catholics, namely, devotion to Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7) and to the Guardian Angels (October 2).

In October 2002, Pope John Paul II wrote his Apostolic Letter *Rosarium Virginis Mariae* (Rosary of the Virgin Mary) in which he added five Mysteries of Light. The Church invites the faithful to reread this Apostolic Letter to deepen their understanding of the beauty of the Rosary and to fervently pray it with their families throughout the month of October.

Our Holy Rosary church community will celebrate this External Solemnity of Our Lady of the Rosary on Sunday, October 9th. We will celebrate the Dominican rite solemn high Mass with a special blessing of the roses, praying the Rosary, and benediction at the 11 am liturgy. Our Knights of Columbus will host a breakfast reception after all of the morning Masses.

The following Sunday, October 16th, we will make the annual Dominican Rosary Student Appeal, which supports the education and formation of the 35 young men currently preparing to be your future Dominican priests and religious brothers. As the Dominicans do not receive any funding from the diocese for the formation of their brothers, your support of the appeal is critical and deeply appreciated. Without God's grace and your help, their formation would not be possible. We have been blessed to receive the fruit of this appeal in our newly ordained priest Fr. Joseph Selinger!!

In October, the other devotion is the feast of Guardian Angels, which dates back to the 11th century. Unfortunately, it is not celebrated this year since the feast falls on a Sunday. Everyone has a guardian angel, and on October 2nd, the Church reminds us of their role. We should express our sincere gratitude to God for placing these angels in our service. Having such a guardian gives us confidence in all the difficulties of life. All Catholics should regularly recite the prayer to our Guardian Angel.
