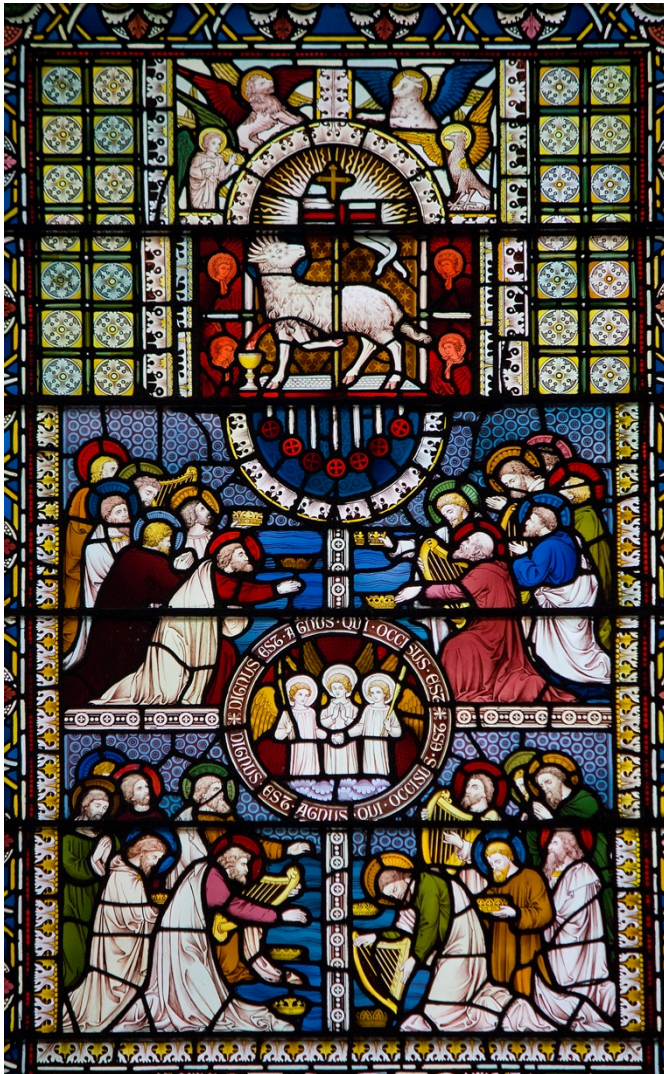

Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

God continues to bless the Dominicans with an increase in vocations. Vocations to the Western Dominican Province have grown 35% over the past ten years, and it's coming at a crucial time. I'm writing to thank you and ask for your continued prayers and financial support for the brothers' information.

With so much intellectual and spiritual poverty, there is an urgent need to share the good news with charity and clarity! Souls are reflecting anew on what it means to be human, to have hope, and to believe in something greater than oneself. And it's here that we Dominicans can help lead souls to Christ, with your support.

We recently invited you to participate in our Rosary Sunday: Dominican Student Appeal, and asked for your help in supporting the education and formation of your future Dominican priests and religious brothers with a gift. If you have made a gift to the appeal already, please accept my heartfelt gratitude and that of all my Dominican brothers. If not, please consider making a gift today at www.opwest.org/rs.

Praise God, our province has been experiencing a vocation increase over the last seven years, and we now have more men in formation than in the last 20 years—41, to be exact. It's a sign that God is raising up faithful religious to help reclaim a culture that is abandoning its Christian roots.

But this work is difficult and requires the support of many people. It costs about \$52,500 per student brother (per year) to fund their room, board, formation, graduate education, and healthcare—that's just \$144 dollars a day and is far below of formation programs. These funds are stretched far, but without your support, we wouldn't have the means to train them for their life of service.

What's more, the Dominicans do not receive support from the Archdiocese of Portland for the formation of our Student Brothers (seminarians). We rely entirely on parishioners and friends like you.

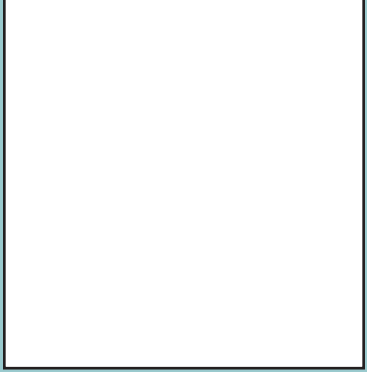
