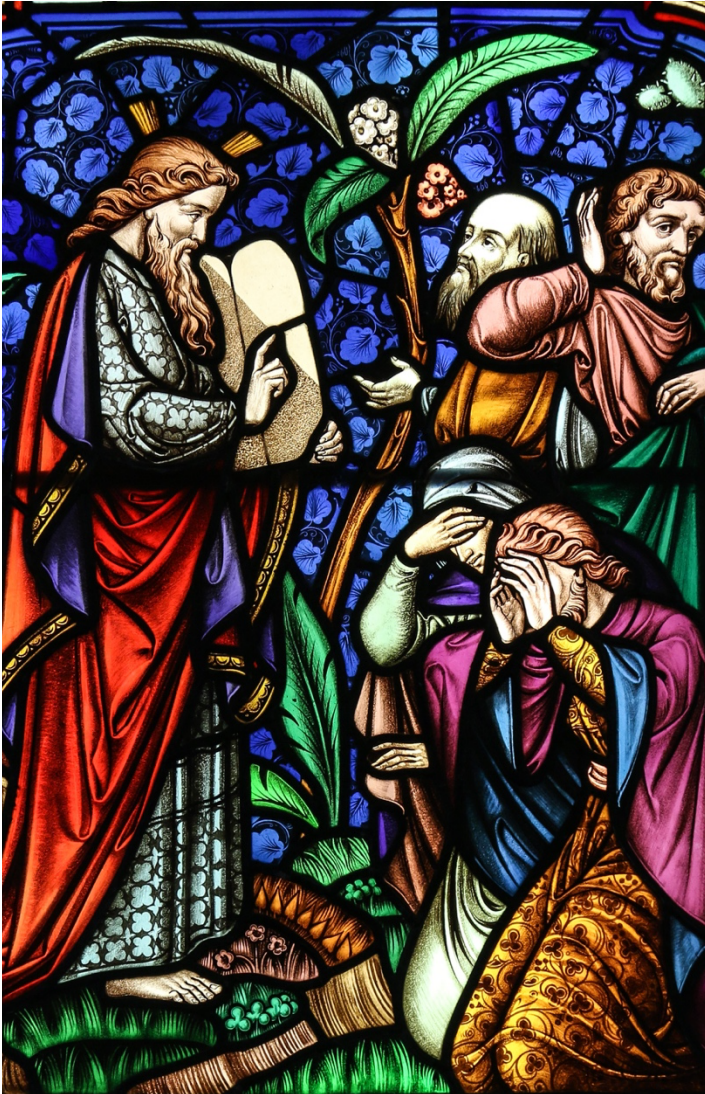

## Dear Parishioners:

In November 1493, Christopher Columbus landed on the island of Puerto Rico. The island was claimed by the Spanish Crown as a colony for the next 400 years. The diocese of San Juan de Puerto Rico was formally established on August 8, 1511 - the future feast day of St. Dominic!

Then, in 1665, Dutch missionaries arrived in the Caribbean. Among those missionaries were Dominican friars who helped establish the Catholic faith among the Taino people - the collective name given to the various indigenous of the island.

In 1898, Puerto Rico became a territory of the United States. Over the centuries, the Dominican friars who minister in Puerto Rico have been Dutch, Spanish, Colombian... and now American. This past year, the Dominican Order handed over administration of the missions in Puerto Rico to the Dominican friars of the United States.



Some of you know that I had my first assignment as a priest in the missions. This coming December I will travel to Puerto Rico to assist the friars there. I plan to be back to Holy Rosary Portland in early January 2022 with lots of stories.

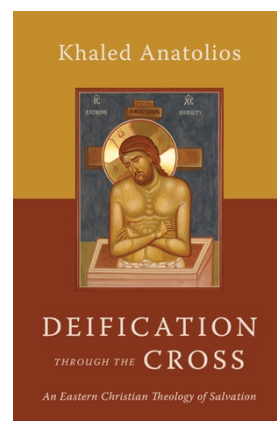
