*Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,*

This past week another important step was taken by a group of Catholics in the Portland area. Two years ago, they were inspired to embark on a very demanding, but desperately needed, project—establish a high school with an impressive curriculum, dedicated to a full and vibrant embrace of the Catholic faith.

Fortunately, there was already a well-developed framework for their ambitious plans. In 2007, a lay-organized group in Minneapolis, MN, under the leadership of prominent author and speaker, Dale Alquist, started an academy inspired by the writings and life of G. K. Chesterton, which they called the Chesterton Academy.

The goal was to remedy the crisis in education of our times, which has deeply affected Catholic schools as well as public, with a new program. It was to provide a Catholic education completely faithful to the Church's teachings, based on the classic works of Western Civilization, and affordable for families. So successful this Minneapolis school has become that other branches of the Chesterton Academy have sprung up throughout the country, forming a network of private, Catholic high schools using the same impressive curriculum. The brief description given on their website is:

- *Students at Chesterton Academy enjoy a cohesive, content-rich education. A broad exposure to many different disciplines helps students expand their interests and uncover hidden talents. Each year builds on the previous, so that by the end of senior year, our students are articulate, clear-thinking, well-rounded, and, very importantly, joyful individuals.*
- *History, literature, philosophy, theology, and languages are braided together in an integrated curriculum utilizing the Socratic Method.*

Last year the local group of parents aspiring to a new Catholic high school for Portland started to implement this Chesterton model here at Holy Rosary. As many parishioners are aware, their classrooms are in Aquinas Hall. Their special patron is Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, after whom this branch of the Chesterton schools is named. They are now beginning their second year, determined to grow, God willing, like the mustard seed in the Gospel, becoming another attractive option for Catholic families in the Portland/Vancouver region. The goal is to move next year to a renovated, former school at St. Stephen's parish, offering better high school facilities and more room to expand.

Please consider supporting this great effort! Get the word out to family and friends about the impressive program of studies. Parents, consider Chesterton for your children. Let's not simply sit back and let the declining cultural climate of Portland and the entire country take away the options we
